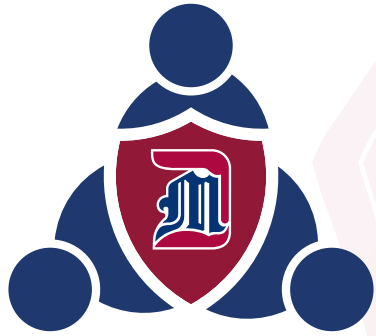

**University of Detroit Mercy Public Safety Department** has many of the same duties and responsibilities as your municipal police force, in addition to campus arrest authority.

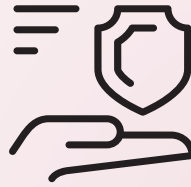
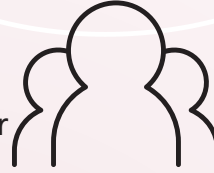
Public safety is responsible for enforcing laws of the state and local ordinances on property owned by Detroit Mercy.

### Services

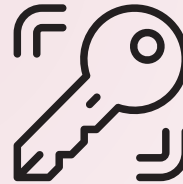
